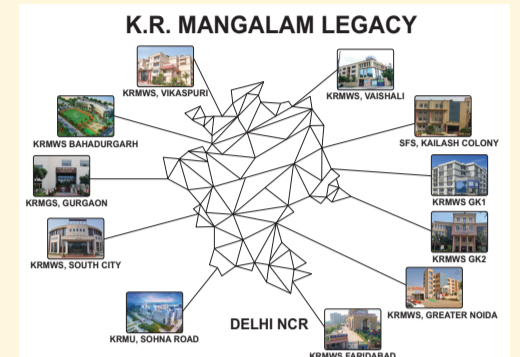

## FATHER'S DAY

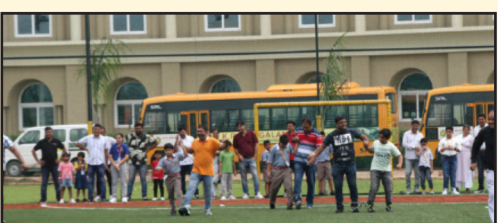
"FATHER: A son's first hero, a daughter's first love."

The children of K.R. Mangalam has



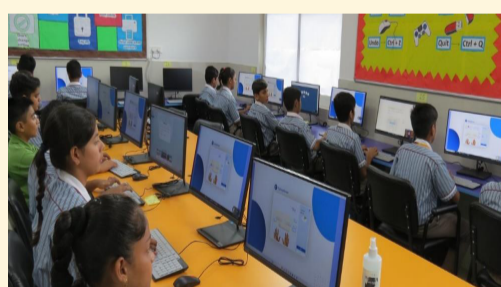

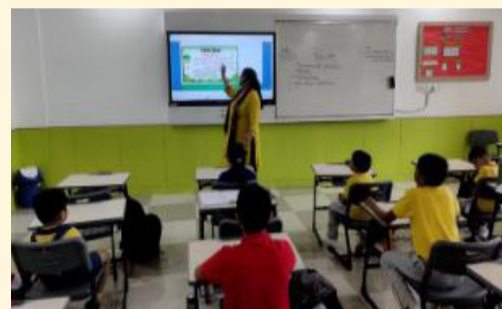

## LITERARY CLUB



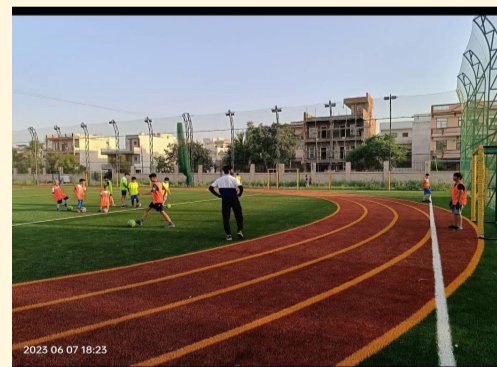

Teaching young children about community helpers is a popular unit, and for good reason. Pre-schoolers love to dress up and do what they see adults do. An activity named

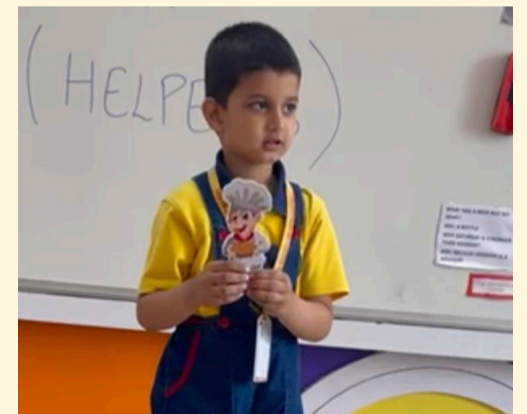

### MAJOR CYBER SECURITY TIPS:-



1. Use Strong, Unique Passwords
2. Enable Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)
3. Update Software Regularly
4. Use a Reliable Antivirus Program
5. Be aware of unsolicited emails and don't click on suspicious links or download attachments from unknown sources.
6. Encrypt Your Data: Use encryption tools to protect sensitive data, both in transit and at rest.
7. Use strong passwords for your Wi-Fi router and enable WPA3 encryption for your network.
8. Turn off or disable unnecessary services and features on your devices and software to reduce potential attack vectors.
9. Enable a firewall on your computer and network to filter

- incoming and outgoing traffic.
10. Back up important files and data to an external device or cloud storage. Ensure backups are automated and stored securely.
  11. Stay informed about the latest cybersecurity threats and best practices to protect yourself online.
  12. Avoid conducting sensitive transactions or accessing confidential information on public Wi-Fi networks.
  13. Use passcodes, PINs, or biometric authentication (fingerprint or facial recognition) to lock your smartphones, tablets, and computers.
  14. Limit the amount of personal information you share on social media platforms, and adjust privacy settings to restrict access to your profile.
  15. Regularly review your bank statements, credit reports, and online accounts for any



- suspicious activity.
16. Change default passwords on Internet of Things (IoT) devices and keep their firmware up to date.
  17. Be mindful of what you share online, as cybercriminals can use personal information for social engineering attacks.
  18. Consider using a reputable password manager to generate, store, and auto-fill complex passwords for your accounts.
  19. Limit user access to your devices and accounts. Use the principle of least privilege to ensure users have only the necessary access rights.
  20. Develop a plan for responding to cybersecurity incidents, including steps to take if you suspect a breach.
